STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Five*

AN ACT enabling non-citizens who are legally authorized to work in the United States to deliver alcohol.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1 226:1 Employee Restrictions; Non-Citizens. Amend RSA 179:20, I to read as follows:  
2 I. No person, except a citizen of the United States or ~~[legal resident alien]~~ ***non-citizen who is***  
3 ***legally authorized to work***, shall be employed to sell or deliver any liquor or beverage.  
226:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
