

Amendment to HB 110

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

3 1 New Section; County Public Safety Revolving Funds. Amend RSA 23 by inserting after section
4 22 the following new section:

5 23:23 County Public Safety Revolving Funds.

6 I. A county may, by vote of the county delegation, establish a county public safety revolving
7 fund for the provision of public safety services by county employees outside of the ordinary detail of
8 such persons, including but not limited to public safety services in connection with special events,
9 highway construction, and other construction projects, or for any other public safety purpose deemed
10 appropriate by the county sheriff.

11 II. If a county establishes a county public safety revolving fund for the purposes identified in
12 paragraph I, it shall deposit into the fund all or any part of the revenues from fees, charges, or other
13 income derived from the activities or services supported by the fund to replenish the fund to the
14 original appropriated amount. The county shall deposit any other revenues approved by the county
15 delegation into the revolving fund, provided that funds in excess of the original appropriated amount
16 shall be deposited into the general fund. The money in the fund shall be allowed to accumulate from
17 year to year. The county treasurer shall have custody of all moneys in the fund, and shall pay out
18 the same only upon order of the county commissioners. Such funds shall be expended only for the
19 purposes for which the fund was created.

20 III. The county delegation may, at the time it establishes a county public safety revolving
21 fund or at any time thereafter, place limitations on expenditures from the fund including, but not
22 limited to, restrictions on the types of items or services that may be purchased from the fund. No
23 amount may be expended from a revolving fund established hereunder for any item or service for
24 which an appropriation has been specifically rejected by the county delegation during the same year.

25 IV. The provisions of this section shall not preclude the establishment of a county public
26 safety revolving fund for any other purpose authorized by law.

27 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
