

Amendment to HB 50

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT relative to intentional or knowing violation of the prohibition on teaching  
4 discrimination.

6 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

8 1 Violations; Prohibition on Teaching Discrimination. Amend RSA 193:40, III-IV to read as  
9 follows:

10 III. Any person claiming to be aggrieved by [a] ***an intentional or knowing violation*** of  
11 this section, including the attorney general, may initiate a civil action against a school or school  
12 district in superior court for legal or equitable relief, or with the New Hampshire commission for  
13 human rights as provided in RSA 354-A:34.

14 IV. [~~Violation~~] ***Intentional or knowing violation*** of this section by an educator shall be  
15 considered a violation of the educator code of conduct that justifies disciplinary sanction by the state  
16 board of education.

17 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill allows a person aggrieved by the intentional or knowing violation of the prohibition on teaching discrimination to initiate civil action against the offending school or district. This bill also deems the intentional or knowing violation of the prohibition by an educator a violation of the educator code of conduct.
