Floor Amendment to HB 143

1 Amend RSA 635:2-a, I (a) and (b) as inserted by section 2 of the bill by replacing it with the
2 following:

4 (a) A no trespass order (NTO) issued to a person which commands such person to leave
5 or not to enter any municipal or school property, shall not be issued to any person unless approved
6 by unanimous vote of the governing body taken in a duly noticed public meeting unless the person
7 that is the subject of the proposed NTO requests that the question be decided in non-public session.

(b) An NTO shall be written and shall include the following information:

9

(1) The date of issuance;

10

(2) The specific public property to which the order applies;

11

(3) A clear explanation of the reason for the NTO;

12

(4) The duration of the NTO, not to exceed 90 days;

13

(5) A statement informing the individual of the right to request a hearing, and if he
14 or she requests a hearing, the right to appear at a hearing to contest the NTO;

15

(6) Instructions on how to request a hearing; and

16

(7) A statement informing the individual of his or her right to ultimately appeal the

order to the superior court following the hearing.
