Amendment to HB 1681

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

3 1 New Subdivision; Innovative Housing Structures. Amend RSA 674 by inserting after section
4 80 the following new subdivision:

5 Innovative Housing Structures

6 674:81 Definitions.

7 I. As used in this subdivision:

8 (a) "Dwelling site" means the property where the innovative housing structure is or will
9 be located when used as a dwelling unit.

10 (b) "Innovative housing structure" or "IHS" means a unique single residential unit such
11 as a tiny house, tiny house on wheels, or a yurt.

12 (c) "Off-site construction" means, for the purposes of this subdivision, any tiny house of
13 closed construction, which is made or assembled in manufacturing facilities off the building site, for
14 installation, or assembly and installation, on the building site. This definition shall not be construed
15 to include any structure labeled in accordance with the Federal Manufactured Housing Construction
16 and Safety Standards Act of 1974, nor shall it include any recreational vehicle or park trailer as
17 defined in American National Standards Institute A119.2, Standard for Recreational Vehicles, or
18 American National Standards Institute A119.5, Standard for Park Trailers, or any building type not
19 subject to the requirements of nationally recognized model building codes.

20 (d) "Tiny house" means a detached building used or intended to be used for human
21 habitation, providing permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking and sanitation that:

22 (1) Is 600 square feet or less in floor area, excluding lofts;

23 (2) Complies with the tiny home provisions of the state building code; and

24 (3) Is constructed on a stable ground surface or foundation.

25 (e) "Tiny house on wheels" or "THOW" means a tiny house built on a trailer chassis
26 without motive power. A THOW shall not be considered a camp trailer or recreational vehicle when
27 constructed for human habitation.

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1 (e) "Yurt" means, for the purposes of this subdivision, a style of tiny house that is a
2 round or similar shape and is a freestanding structure modeled after traditional nomadic dwellings,
3 constructed with contemporary materials and engineering for use as a permanent or long-term
4 residence.

5 674:82 Location and Use.

6 I. A municipality may permit an innovative housing structure to be placed or erected on an
7 individual house lot where single-family dwellings are allowed, or to be used as an accessory
8 dwelling unit pursuant to RSA 674:72, subject to all applicable land use requirements.

9 II. Innovative housing structures shall be treated as single-family dwellings or accessory
10 dwelling units for zoning purposes and shall meet all applicable state laws and regulations regarding
11 drinking water supply and wastewater treatment and disposal.

12 674:83 Property Tax Assessment.

13 I. A municipality may assess and collect property tax for an innovative housing structure
14 that:

15 (a) Is affixed to the property, including by way of utility connection;

16 (b) Is in a state of completeness or permanency;

17 (c) Has been located on the property for more than 180 days.

18 II. If an innovative housing structure is removed from the property, the property owner
19 shall notify the municipality for reassessment purposes.

20 674:84 Transportation of Mobile Structures.

21 I. If an innovative housing structure is permanently built on a flatbed trailer chassis for
22 transportation to the dwelling site, and the trailer conforms to all vehicle trailer requirements for
23 roadworthiness, the builder may use:

24 (a) A dealer plate; or

25 (b) A temporary trailer plate issued by the department of motor vehicles.

26 II. Such plates may be used to move the structure from the building site to the dwelling site
27 or, if sold, from one dwelling site to another.

28 2 New Section; New Hampshire Building Code; Innovative Housing Structure Construction
29 Document. Amend RSA 155-A by inserting after section 3-c the following new section:

30 155-A:3-d Innovative Housing Structure Construction Document Reviews and Inspections.

31 I. An innovative housing structure, as defined in RSA 674:81, constructed on the dwelling
32 site shall comply with the state building code.

33 II. Where the innovative housing structure is off-site construction, construction document
34 review and inspection of the manufactured elements shall comply with either:

35 (a) Construction document review and inspection requirements of the state building
36 code; or

37 (b) Modular buildings pursuant to RSA 205-C.

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1 III. If an innovative housing structure is off-site construction, construction document review
2 and inspections may be performed by:

3 (a) The appointed building official in the New Hampshire municipality where the off-site
4 construction facility is located, provided that the building official is certified as a residential building
5 inspector by the International Code Council;

6 (b) Another approved agency in accordance with the state building code building site; or

7 (c) The state fire marshal or designee through the Modular Building program.

8 IV. The off-site construction approval issued under this subdivision for the manufactured
9 elements, if conforming to state building code, shall be accepted by the local building official at the
10 dwelling site for purposes of issuing a certificate of occupancy.

11 V. A municipality at the dwelling site may review submittal documents and inspection for
12 compliance with the New Hampshire state building code for project elements other than
13 manufactured elements.

14 3 New Paragraph; Sewage Disposal Systems; Rulemaking. Amend RSA 485-A:41 by inserting
15 after paragraph V the following new paragraph:

16 VI. Adopt rules, pursuant to 541-A, regarding wastewater treatment and disposal for
17 innovative housing structures as defined in 674:81.

18 4 New Paragraph; Modular Building Standards; Rulemaking. Amend RSA 205-C:4 by inserting
19 after paragraph VII the following new paragraph:

20 VIII. Application of ICC/MBI Standard 1200 and ICC/MBI Standard 1205.

21 5 Amend RSA 205-C:1, XI to read as follows:

22 XI. "Modular building" means any building of closed construction, which is made or
23 assembled in manufacturing facilities off the building site, for installation, or assembly and
24 installation, on the building site. This definition shall not be construed to include any structure
25 labeled in accordance with the Federal Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards
26 Act of 1974, nor shall it include single-wide structures under 750 square feet, provided that they are
27 not for ~~[residential or]~~ classroom use, ***nor shall it include an innovative housing structure***
28 ***pursuant to RSA 674:81 unless the modular program is chosen by the applicant***, nor shall it
29 include any recreational vehicle or park trailer as defined in American National Standards Institute
30 A119.2, Standard for Recreational Vehicles, or A119.5, Standard for Park Trailers, or any building
31 type not subject to the requirements of nationally recognized model building codes.

32 6 Building Code Review Board; State Building Code. The New Hampshire state building code
33 review board shall amend the state building code to reflect section 1 through 5 of this act.

34 7 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill establishes standards for innovative housing structures, including tiny houses, tiny houses on wheels, and yurts, authorizes their use as single-family or accessory dwellings, sets construction, inspection, and off-site manufacturing requirements, provides for municipal property tax assessment, regulates transportation, and directs related rulemaking under the state building code and wastewater and modular building statutes.
