Amendment to SB 466-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing section 1 with the following:

3 1 Public Safety and Welfare; Changing Marks on a Firearm. Amend RSA 159:13 to read as  
4 follows:

5 159:13 Changing Marks. No person shall change, alter, remove, or obliterate the name of the  
6 maker, model, manufacturer's number, or other mark of identification on any pistol or revolver, **or**  
7 ***any other firearm, except for an antique firearm as defined in 18 U.S.C. section 921(a)(16).***  
8 Possession of any such firearms upon which the same shall have been changed, altered, removed, or  
9 obliterated shall be presumptive evidence that such possessor has changed, altered, removed, or  
10 obliterated the same. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a  
11 [~~misdemeanor~~] ***class A felony.***

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill makes it a class A felony to change, alter, remove or obliterate the name of the maker, model, manufacturer's number, or other mark of identification on a firearm other than an antique firearm.
