1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT relative to a flood resilience section in municipal master plans.

5 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

7 1 New Subparagraph; Master Plan; Flood Resilience Section. Amend RSA 674:2, III by
8 inserting after subparagraph p the following new subparagraph:

9 (q) A flood resilience section which identifies existing and potential flood risks affecting
10 the municipality, including but not limited to riverine flooding, stormwater runoff, culverts, drainage
11 systems, erosion-prone areas, and areas subject to repeated flood damage, and which establishes
12 goals and recommendations for reducing flood-related risks to public safety, property, municipal
13 infrastructure, evacuation routes, and emergency access.

14 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
