AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill:

I. Directs the department of administrative services to take possession of the Sununu youth services center (SYSC) property, to negotiate any contracts necessary for the sale of the property, subject to approval by the governor and council, and authorizes the department to request an additional appropriation to maintain the property, subject to approval of the fiscal committee and governor and council.

II. Provides that proceeds from the sale of the SYSC property shall be deposited in the youth development center settlement fund.
