HOUSE BILL **1074**

AN ACT extending the time period for the remission of certain OHRV and snowmobile fees.

ANALYSIS

This bill extends the time period for the remission of certain OHRV and snowmobile fees.

AN ACT extending the time period for the remission of certain OHRV and snowmobile fees.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Agent's Accounting; OHRV License Fees. Amend RSA 214-A:4 to read as follows:

2 214-A:4 Agent's Accounting.

3 I. Except where a different agent fee, or no fee, is required by law or department rule, the
4 agent shall collect from the licensee a fee of \$1 for each license type issued on a license form and
5 shall account to the executive director for the full face value of the licenses sold. He or she shall pay
6 to the executive director no later than the ~~[fourteenth]~~ **last business day** of each month the full face
7 value of all licenses sold up to the first of the same month and shall report the names and addresses
8 of all persons to whom licenses have been sold and such other information as may be requested on
9 blanks to be furnished by the executive director. All licenses sold at the department headquarters or
10 any subagency thereof shall charge the same fee as outlined in this paragraph, and shall be credited
11 to the fish and game fund.

12 II. The agent shall collect from the applicant a fee of \$5 for each OHRV and snowmobile
13 registration issued and shall account to the executive director for the full face value of the
14 registration decals. He or she shall pay to the executive director no later than the ~~[fourteenth]~~ **last**
15 **business day** of each month the full face value of all registrations sold up to the first of the same
16 month and shall report the names and addresses of all persons to whom registration decals have
17 been sold and such other information as may be requested on blanks to be furnished by the executive
18 director. All registrations sold at the department headquarters or any subagency thereof shall
19 charge the same fee as outlined in this paragraph, and shall be credited to the fish and game fund.

20 III. ~~[When the fourteenth of any month falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the~~
21 ~~accounting and payment due date will be advanced to the first succeeding day that is not a Saturday,~~
22 ~~Sunday, or holiday.~~

23 IV.] If the accounting and payment required by paragraphs ~~[I-III]~~ **I and II** of this section
24 are mailed, they will be considered to have been reported or paid on time if they are properly
25 addressed and postmarked by a United States Post Office no later than the ~~[fourteenth]~~ **last**
26 **business day** of the month in which they are due.

27 [V.] IV. If the accounting and payment required by paragraphs ~~[I-III]~~ **I and II** of this section
28 are delinquent, the agent shall be assessed and pay a penalty equal to 10 percent of the amount due
29 or \$10, whichever is greater. Penalties collected hereunder shall be credited to the fish and game
30 fund.

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1 ~~[VI.]~~ **V.** If the accounting and payment remains delinquent 30 days after the due date
2 required by paragraphs ~~[I-III]~~ **I and II** of this section, the agency status shall be terminated.

3 ~~[VII.]~~ **VI.** If the penalty required by paragraph ~~[V]~~ **IV** of this section remains delinquent 30
4 days after notification of such delinquency, the agency shall be terminated and all penalties shall be
5 deferred.

6 ~~[VIII.]~~ **VII.** The executive director shall have the authority to waive the requirements of
7 paragraphs ~~[V, VI, and VII]~~ **IV, V, and VI** when in his or her judgment there is just cause to do so.

8 ~~[IX.]~~ **VIII.** The executive director shall adopt rules, pursuant to RSA 541-A, concerning the
9 administration of this section for all agents regulated by this chapter.

10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
