HOUSE BILL ***1126***

AN ACT repealing the certification requirement to perform residential mold assessments.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT repealing the certification requirement to perform residential mold assessments.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Repeal. RSA 310-A:189-b, relative to mold assessment certifications, is repealed.
- 2 2 Directive; Report Required; Office of Professional Licensure and Certification. The office of
- 3 professional licensure and certification (OPLC) shall repeal any administrative rules adopted
- 4 pursuant to RSA 310-A:189-b, and shall inform the general court in a report to the speaker of the
- 5 house of representatives and the senate president by January 1, 2027 if the OPLC believes any
- 6 further statutory changes are necessary to accomplish the goals of this act.
- 7 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
