ANALYSIS

This bill designates the Honor and Remember Flag as a state symbol of remembrance of those who died in the line of duty or as a result of service.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT relative to Gold Star Mother's Day.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Gold Star Mother's and Family's Day. RSA 4:13-h, II is repealed and reenacted to read as
2 follows:

3 II. The Honor and Remember Flag, created by the national organization Honor and
4 Remember Inc., is hereby recognized as a New Hampshire symbol honoring the service and sacrifice
5 of New Hampshire's men and women who served in the United States Armed Forces and gave their
6 lives while serving or as a result of serving, as well as their families. The governor shall order the
7 Honor and Remember Flag to be displayed daily at the New Hampshire state veterans cemetery in
8 Boscawen and at the State House in the most junior order of precedence on the last Sunday in
9 September.

10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
