This resolution urges counties to establish and support the growth of co-ed sports leagues.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six*

A RESOLUTION urging New Hampshire counties to establish co-ed sports leagues.

1       Whereas, inclusive recreational opportunities foster community engagement, personal  
2 development, and social cohesion across all demographics; and

3       Whereas, traditional gender-segregated sports leagues may unintentionally reinforce outdated  
4 norms and limit participation for individuals who do not identify with binary gender categories; and

5       Whereas, co-ed sports leagues promote equality, mutual respect, and teamwork among  
6 participants of all genders; now, therefore, be it

7       Resolved by the House of Representatives:

8       That the counties are hereby urged to establish and support co-ed sports leagues that encourage  
9 men and women to compete together voluntarily, therefore allowing individuals identifying as  
10 transgender to compete voluntarily outside of more forceful gender-based competition within the  
11 public school system.

12       That the counties actively pursue fundraising strategies to ensure the sustainability and growth  
13 of these co-ed sports leagues.

14       That the house clerk is hereby directed to transmit copies of this resolution to each county in the  
15 state and the New Hampshire Association of Counties.
