HOUSE BILL ***1344***

AN ACT relative to intermunicipal compacts.

SPONSORS: Rep. Sweeney, Rock. 25

COMMITTEE: Municipal and County Government

ANALYSIS

This bill authorizes 2 or more contiguous municipalities to enter into a compact establishing an intermunicipal governing authority for the purpose of jointly providing one or more municipal services.

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

II. No authority created under this chapter shall have independent taxing power unless expressly granted by an act of the legislature.

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1 53-H:5 Withdrawal; Dissolution.

2 I. A municipality may withdraw in accordance with the terms of the compact.

3 II. An authority may be dissolved by concurrent majority vote of the legislative bodies of all
4 member municipalities, or as otherwise provided in the compact.

5 53-H:6 Oversight.

6 All records and proceedings of an intermunicipal governing authority shall be subject to RSA 91-
7 A and RSA 32 unless otherwise provided in this chapter.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
