ANALYSIS

This bill authorizes municipalities to use revolving funds to support energy services under approved electric aggregation plans.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Subparagraph; Revolving Funds. Amend RSA 31:95-h, I by inserting after subparagraph
- 2 (g) the following new subparagraph:
- 3 (h) Facilitating the provision of energy services pursuant to the approved electric
- 4 aggregation plan under RSA 53-E, provided that no funds raised from local taxes shall be used for
- 5 such purposes.
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
