SENATE BILL **11**

AN ACT relative to the allocation of electoral college votes.

ANALYSIS

This bill apportions the state's presidential electors so that 2 at-large presidential electors shall cast their ballots for the presidential and vice-presidential candidates who received the highest number of votes in the state, and congressional district presidential electors shall cast their ballots for the presidential and vice-presidential candidates who received the highest number of votes in their respective congressional districts.

AN ACT relative to the allocation of electoral college votes.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1       1 Nomination of Presidential Electors; Designation. Amend RSA 655:54 to read as  
2 follows:

3           655:54 Nomination of Presidential Electors. Presidential electors shall be nominated by  
4 state party conventions as provided in RSA 667:21. ***Each party shall nominate 2 at-large***  
5 ***presidential electors and one presidential elector for each congressional district.***

6       2 Meetings of Presidential Electors; Conduct; Apportionment. Amend RSA 660:29 to read as  
7 follows:

8           660:29 Conduct. The electors shall give their votes for president and vice-president of the  
9 United States in Concord on said day and shall proceed according to law. ***Each at-large***  
10 ***presidential elector shall cast his or her ballot for the presidential and vice-presidential***  
11 ***candidates who received the highest number of votes in the state. Each congressional***  
12 ***district presidential elector shall cast his or her ballot for the presidential and vice-***  
13 ***presidential candidates who received the highest number of votes in his or her***  
14 ***congressional district.***

15       3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
