HOUSE BILL **1287**

AN ACT relative to special number plates for veterans and eligibility therefore.

SPONSORS: Rep. Corcoran, Hills. 28

COMMITTEE: Science, Technology and Energy

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill changes rules regarding the distribution of special number plates for veterans and eligibility therefore.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to special number plates for veterans and eligibility therefore.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Statutory Construction. Amend RSA 21:50, I(a)(2) to read as follows:

2 (2) Has been discharged or released from duty in the United States armed forces

3 with:

4 (A) An honorable discharge; or

5 (B) An uncharacterized discharge based on a service-connected injury, illness, or

6 disability; *or*

7 (C) ***A general discharge under honorable conditions.***

8 2 Special Number Plates for Veterans. Amend RSA 261:87-b, I to read as follows:

9 I. The director is hereby authorized to issue special number plates to be used on motor
10 vehicles owned by veterans of the United States armed services, in lieu of other number plates. The
11 design of these special plates shall be determined by the commissioner, and shall be distinct from
12 the design or designs of those plates issued under RSA 261:86. Such plates shall be issued to
13 veterans as defined in RSA 21:50, I(a) and veterans discharged or released from duty in the United
14 States armed forces with a general discharge under honorable conditions upon application, proof of
15 veteran status in a form authorized by RSA 21:50, I(b), and payment of the regular motor vehicle
16 registration fee and the \$4 per plate fees under RSA 261:75. ~~[The director shall also issue such~~
17 ~~plates to any person providing proof of honorable discharge from the armed services of any nation~~
18 ~~allied with the United States during World War II and proof of such person's service during World~~
19 ~~War II.]~~ Renewals of such special number plates shall be charged the fee assessed for standard
20 motor vehicles as prescribed under RSA 261:141. The plates furnished pursuant to this section are
21 non-transferable, except that the surviving spouse may use the plates indefinitely after the death of
22 the veteran until the date that the surviving spouse remarries.

23 3 Eligibility. Amend RSA 261-C:3 to read as follows:

24 261-C:3 Eligibility. Multi-use veterans decal plates shall be issued only to those veterans
25 defined in RSA 21:50, I[(a)]. Additionally, an individual shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the
26 director of the division of veteran's services that he or she was a member of a specific branch of
27 service or was awarded the medal represented on the requested decal. The plates furnished
28 pursuant to this section are non-transferable except that the surviving spouse may use the plates
29 indefinitely after the death of the veteran until the date that the surviving spouse remarries.

30 4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
