1407

AN ACT enabling veterinary technicians to provide rabies vaccinations while indirectly supervised by a veterinarian.

ANALYSIS

This bill enables veterinary technicians to provide rabies vaccinations while indirectly supervised by a veterinarian.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT enabling veterinary technicians to provide rabies vaccinations while indirectly supervised by a veterinarian.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Definitions; Vaccination Against Rabies. Amend RSA 436:99, II to read as follows:

2 II. "Vaccination against rabies" shall mean the inoculation of a dog, cat, or ferret with a
3 rabies vaccine licensed by the United States Department of Agriculture. [~~Such vaccination shall be~~
4 ~~performed by a veterinarian duly licensed to practice veterinary medicine.~~]

5 2 Authorization to Vaccinate. New Paragraphs; Vaccination Against Rabies; Authorization to
6 Vaccinate. Amend RSA 436:100 by inserting after paragraph II the following new paragraph:

7 III. Vaccination against rabies may be performed either by a veterinarian licensed to
8 practice in New Hampshire or by a veterinary technician, as defined in rules adopted by the board of
9 veterinary medicine under RSA 541-A, working under the direct supervision of such veterinarian.

10 3 Rabies Vaccination; Statement. Amend RSA 436:101, I to read as follows:

11 I. Before vaccinating any dog, cat, or ferret for rabies, the veterinarian **or veterinary**
12 **technician** shall receive the following statement completed by the dog's, cat's, or ferret's owner [~~in~~
13 ~~the veterinarian's presence~~] on the same day: I, _____ (owner's name) _____, swear that to
14 my knowledge this dog, cat, or ferret has not bitten anyone within 10 days. The veterinarian shall
15 retain the statement in the veterinarian's files until the dog's, cat's, or ferret's next vaccination.

16 4 Duty of Veterinarian or Veterinary Technician. Amend RSA 436:102 to read as follows:

17 436:102 Duties of Veterinarian.

18 It shall be the duty of each veterinarian **or veterinary technician**, at the time of vaccinating
19 any dog, cat, or ferret, to complete a certificate of rabies vaccination in triplicate which includes the
20 following information: **the signature of the veterinarian or person authorized by the**
21 **veterinarian to provide a signature**, owner's name and address, description of dog, cat, or ferret
22 (breed, sex, markings, age, name), date of vaccination, rabies vaccination tag number, type of rabies
23 vaccine administered, manufacturer's serial number of vaccine, and the expiration date of the
24 vaccination. Distribution of copies of the certificate shall be: the original to the owner, one copy
25 retained by the issuing **or supervising** veterinarian and, within 40 days of the vaccination, one copy
26 to the town or city clerk where the dog, cat, or ferret is kept. The veterinarian and the owner shall
27 retain their copies for the interval between vaccinations specified in RSA 436:100. A metal or
28 durable plastic tag, serially numbered, shall be securely attached to the collar or harness of the dog.
29 Whenever the dog is out-of-doors, off the owner's premises, and not under the control of the owner or
30 handler while working the dog, the collar or harness with the vaccination tag shall be worn. For the

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1 purposes of this section, "working the dog" means a dog doing a defined functional canine activity
2 with its owner or handler such as hunting, field work, drafting, and guarding, working, or herding
3 livestock, as defined in RSA 21:34-a, II(a)(4), or participating in any lawful competitive event,
4 including, but not limited to, conformation shows or obedience trials, field trials, agility events,
5 hunts, sled races, or training activities pertinent to functional canine activities. Cats and ferrets
6 shall not be required to wear the collar or harness with the tag.

7 5 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
