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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Six

AN ACT relative to pet transfers.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Sale of Pets and Disposition of Unclaimed Animals; Transfer of Animals and Birds; Health
2 Certificates for Dogs, Cats, and Ferrets. Amend the title of RSA 437:8 to read as follows:

3 437:8 ~~[Health Certificates]~~ **Official Certificates of Transfer** for Dogs, Cats, and Ferrets.

4 2 ***Sale of Pets and Disposition of Unclaimed Animals; Transfer of Animals and Birds;***
5 ***Confidentiality.*** Amend RSA 437:8-b, V to read as follows:

6 V. ~~[Certificates of transfer]~~ **Official certificates of transfer** shall be removed from the
7 animal records database after 4 years.

8 3 Health Certificate; Official Certificate of Transfer. Amend RSA 437:8, VI(f) to read as follows:

9 (f) No animal shelter shall transfer any dog, cat, or ferret that is received from outside of
10 the state without an official ~~[health certificate]~~ **certificate of transfer** and until the quarantine
11 requirements in RSA 437:8, IV have been met.

12 4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
