Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Repeal. The following are repealed:

2 I. RSA 187-A:38, relative to the title of the Service Registration Awareness and Compliance
3 Act.

4 II. RSA 187-A:39, relative to the application of the Service Registration Awareness and
5 Compliance Act.

6 III. RSA 187-A:40, relative to those responsible for complying with the Service Registration
7 Awareness and Compliance Act.

8 IV. RSA 187-A:41, relative to the exceptions to the Service Registration Awareness and
9 Compliance Act.

10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
