3 (a) Any credit union may pay to each of the members of the board of directors, credit
4 committee, and supervisory committee for his or her services as a member of the board or committee a
5 sum that may, from time to time, be fixed by the members at an annual meeting. No officers, directors, or
6 employees shall receive any other compensation or fee for services provided to the credit union beyond
7 their compensation as officers, directors, or employees.
