HOUSE BILL ***139-LOCAL***

AN ACT relative to the official designation of holidays by municipalities and educational institutions.

COMMITTEE: Municipal and County Government

ANALYSIS

This bill removes the requirement that municipalities, schools, colleges, and universities use official holiday designations.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Repeal. The following are repealed:
- 2 I. RSA 31:6-a, relative to official holiday designations.
- 3 II. RSA 288:4, III, relative to school holidays.
- 4 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
