Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Paragraph; Prohibited Practice and Security Deposits; Certain Specific Acts Prohibited.
- 2 Amend RSA 540-A:3 by inserting after paragraph IX the following new paragraph:
- 3 X. A landlord shall not require a tenant or prospective tenant to pay any amount due under
- 4 a residential lease, renewal, or extension agreement via electronic funds transfer, including, but not
- 5 limited to, any automatic, recurring electronic funds transfers.
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2026.
