HOUSE BILL **398**

AN ACT requiring holocaust and genocide studies in public schools to include the impacts on people with disabilities.

SPONSORS: Rep. Ball, Rock. 25

COMMITTEE: Education Policy and Administration

ANALYSIS

This bill directs the state board of education to require that school districts provide instruction in holocaust and genocide studies, including the impact of such events on people with disabilities.

AN ACT requiring holocaust and genocide studies in public schools to include the impacts
on people with disabilities.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; State Board of Education; Holocaust and Genocide Studies, to Include the
2 Impacts on People with Disabilities. Amend RSA 186:11 by inserting after paragraph XXXVII the
3 following new paragraph:

4 XXXVIII. Require school districts to adopt a policy governing instruction in holocaust and
5 genocide studies, which shall include the impact of such events on individuals with disabilities.

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
