This bill enables absentee voting when the National Weather Service declares any severe weather watch or warning.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Five*

AN ACT relative to weather conditions which enable absentee voting.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           1 Absence, Religious Observance, and Disability Absentee Voting. Amend the introductory  
2 paragraph in RSA 657:1, II to read as follows:

3           II. When the National Weather Service has issued [~~a winter storm warning, blizzard~~  
4 ~~warning, or ice storm warning~~] **any severe weather watch or warning** for election day applicable  
5 to the city, town, or unincorporated place:

6           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
