AN ACT removing requirements that schools provide menstrual products in restrooms.

This bill repeals the requirement that school districts provide menstrual hygiene products at no cost.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Repeal. RSA 189:16-a, relative to menstrual hygiene products in schools, is repealed.
- 2 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
