HOUSE BILL **461**

AN ACT relative to department of safety and department of motor vehicle training and testing materials.

ANALYSIS

This bill requires all printed and digitally available driver's license examination-related materials, including the examination itself, be available and administered in the English language only.

AN ACT relative to department of safety and department of motor vehicle training and testing materials.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Section; Language Requirements for Driver's License Examination and Examination-
2 Related Materials. Amend RSA 263 by inserting after section 263:6-d the following new section:

3 263:6-e Language Requirements for Driver's License Examination and Examination-Related
4 Materials.

5 I. All driver's license examinations and examination-related materials, whether in print or
6 available digitally, shall be displayed or otherwise distributed in the English language only, except
7 that American Sign Language shall be used for individuals who communicate using sign language.

8 II. The department of safety shall deny any and all requests, regardless of circumstance, for
9 an examination in a language other than English or American Sign Language. A person required to
10 take any examination as a condition for license renewal or reinstatement shall be required to take
11 the examination in English or American Sign Language.

12 III. The commissioner of the department of safety and the director of the division of motor
13 vehicles shall not acquire any digitally produced or printed material described in paragraph I of this
14 section that is in any language other than English or American Sign Language, notwithstanding
15 contractual agreements made prior to the effective date of this section.

16 IV. Any surplus non-English or non-American Sign Language examination or examination-
17 related material remaining or existing in the possession of the division of motor vehicles after the
18 effective date of this section shall not be distributed or displayed for any reason.

19 V. The department of safety shall adopt rules in accordance with RSA 541-A regarding this
20 section.

21 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2026.
