AN ACT                    establishing a committee to study the use and problems associated with regulating the distribution and disposal of certain solid waste within landfills and transfer centers.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study the use and problems  
2 associated with regulating the distribution and disposal of certain solid waste within landfills and  
3 transfer centers.

4            2 Membership and Compensation.

5            I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

6            (a) Two members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house  
7 of representatives.

8            (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

9            II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to  
10 the duties of the committee.

11           3 Duties. The committee shall examine the use and problems associated with regulating the  
12 distribution and disposal of certain solid waste within landfills and transfer centers. The committee  
13 shall review past legislation on subject and may solicit information and testimony from any  
14 individual or entity with experience or expertise relevant to the study.

15           4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from  
16 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house  
17 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this  
18 section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

19           5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed  
20 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house  
21 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2025.

22           6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
