SENATE BILL **89**

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Five

AN ACT enabling non-citizens who are legally authorized to work in the United States to deliver alcohol.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Employee Restrictions; Non-Citizens. Amend RSA 179:20, I to read as follows:
- 2 I. No person, except a citizen of the United States or ~~[legal resident alien]~~ **legally**
- 3 **authorized to work**, shall be employed to sell or deliver any liquor or beverage.
- 4 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
