AN ACT                    relative to reporting requirements for the New Hampshire advisory council on career and technical education.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 Advisory Council on Career and Technical Education; Annual Report. RSA 188-E:10-b, VI(b)  
2 is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

3                    (b) The annual report shall include details concerning the current state of career and  
4 technical education at the secondary educational level in New Hampshire including:

5                    (1) The status of the delivery system of career and technical education in New  
6 Hampshire;

7                    (2) Potential means to increase access to career and technical education programs;

8                    (3) Potential means to increase partnerships between businesses, skilled trades,  
9 advanced manufacturing, and CTE programs;

10                    (4) The status of establishment and implementation of individual learning plans  
11 beginning in grade 6; and

12                    (5) Other barriers as may be identified that restrict the delivery of career and  
13 technical education to all interested students.

14            2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
