SENATE BILL **299**

AN ACT relative to penalties for contractors violating water pollution and waste disposal regulations.

SPONSORS: Sen. Pearl, Dist 17

COMMITTEE: Energy and Natural Resources

ANALYSIS

This bill imposes penalties on contractors who supervise or perform work in violation of the shoreland water quality protection act.

AN ACT relative to penalties for contractors violating water pollution and waste disposal regulations.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Shoreland Water Quality Protection Penalties. Amend RSA 483-B:18 by
2 inserting after paragraph III the following new paragraph:

3 IV. Contractors who supervise or do any work violating the provisions of this chapter shall
4 be subject to the following:

5 (a) Upon petition of the attorney general or the municipality in which the violation
6 occurred, the superior court may levy upon any person violating this chapter a civil penalty in an
7 amount not to exceed \$5,000 for each violation. The superior court shall have jurisdiction to restrain
8 a continuing violation of this chapter and to require remediation.

9 (b) The commissioner, after notice and hearing pursuant to RSA 541-A, may impose an
10 administrative fine of up to \$5,000 for each offense upon any person who violates this chapter.
11 Rehearings and appeals relating to such fines shall be governed by RSA 541. Imposition of an
12 administrative fine under this section shall not preclude the imposition of further civil penalties
13 under this chapter.

14 (c) Notwithstanding the \$5,000 fine limit in subparagraph (b), the administrative fine
15 for each repeat violation of this chapter may be multiplied by a factor of 2 for every previous
16 violation committed by the person or entity.

17 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2026.
