10 Amend paragraph I as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

12 I. There is established a committee to study the cost and liability of providing general
13 education and special education services to New Hampshire students who are placed in residential
14 facilities, including but not limited to students placed in residential facilities in the state as an
15 episode of treatment or under a court ordered placement under RSA 169-B, RSA 169-C, and RSA
16 169-D.
