## HOUSE JOURNAL No. 1

Wednesday, December 5, 2012

On the first Wednesday in December in the year of our Lord, two thousand twelve, it being the day designated by the Constitution for assembling for organizational purposes, the one hundred and sixty-third General Court of the State of New Hampshire convened at the Capitol in the City of Concord. The Representatives-elect were called to order by Karen O. Wadsworth, Clerk of the House for the preceding session.

Prayer was offered by the Reverend Canon Charles LaFond, Canon for Congregational Life of the Episcopal Diocese of New Hampshire.

#### REMARKS

**Speaker Norelli:** Thank you and good morning everyone. Congratulations on your election and welcome to the New Hampshire House! I remember being in your position back in 1996. As a freshman member of the House I did not know what to expect let alone where to find the bathrooms or the tunnel. The one thing I quickly learned is that this great legislative chamber works the best when we work together. As newly elected and re-elected members of the House, we have been honored by the voters in our districts. The citizens of the great State of New Hampshire sent us here with a message. They want a Legislature that puts partisan politics aside and works, in a respectful way, on the issues that matter to Granite Staters and that is exactly what we should all plan to do. Let me be clear. We will not always agree, but we must move beyond the partisan divide and begin to work together on behalf of all of our constituents. We must keep our promises by focusing on jobs and the economy and delivering a responsible budget that meets the needs of the citizens and businesses of our state and we certainly must end the harshness in the air that has so plagued the House these last two years. During my previous terms as Speaker, I tried to focus on ensuring that all members were heard and included in the process. Just because one political party holds a majority does not mean the other political party is irrelevant, in fact, each of our votes matter just as much. It is near impossible to work together on the issues that face our state if you do not meet with each other to talk. As Speaker, I will return to having weekly meetings with the Republican and Democratic caucus

leaders. This is a small step, but it is a meaningful one. We have all been given a special trust by the voters who sent us here. We owe it to them and to each other to live up to that trust. We must have an open and transparent process that allows us to work on behalf of our state, not our parties or special interests. These next two years will be challenging ones and we will face no shortage of difficult decisions. The question before us is not whether we will face these challenges; but rather when we face them, will we work together to find common ground and compromise or will we resort to politics as usual? I hope we all choose common ground and compromise. I believe Granite Staters have grown wary of the lack of cooperation in government. Let us work together to show them we have heard their concerns and we have made them a priority as we do their business. I want to take a moment to thank my husband, Allen, who is here in the gallery and both of my children, who are unable to be here, for their unwavering support. And I want to thank all of your families for their willingness to take on a greater workload at home in order to allow us the time to work on behalf of the citizens of New Hampshire in the only truly volunteer legislature in the country. I know I say thank you from all of us. Lastly, in the spirit of starting off on the right foot in building relationships, I want to invite all House members and their guests to come by the Speaker's Office after session to share cookies and cider. Congratulations again, and thank you for the trust you have placed in me as your Speaker. I look forward to working with you as we move our great state forward.
