➤ Tarping, landscape fabric, and straw mulch: used for managing weeds, protecting soils, and terminating cover crops.

➤ Cover Cropping: planting soil building crops like rye, clovers, and tillage radish before the next crop add nitrogen, organic matter, and stabilize soil.

➤ Organic soil amendments, like composts, sheep manure, and organic fertilizers help build healthy, nutrient rich soils.



➤ Crop diversification and Plot Rotations over the years manage build up of any diseases, nutrient deficiencies, or insect pest build up.

➤ Insect netting and crop covers for organic insect control and extending the growing season
