To the Members on the New Hampshire House Science, Technology and Energy Committee,

I am writing today to ask you to vote against both HB219 and HB567 which will destroy our state's progress in the use of our own huge wood resource for heating our buildings. Spring Ledge Farm has invested in a wood chip boiler which now heats our complex of buildings and greenhouses in New London, eliminating the use of thousands of gallons of #2 fuel oil each year. Instead, we use wood chips produced by our state's loggers, foresters, truckers, and wood fuel processors. These industries employ many in our state and keep our energy dollars right here in our state.

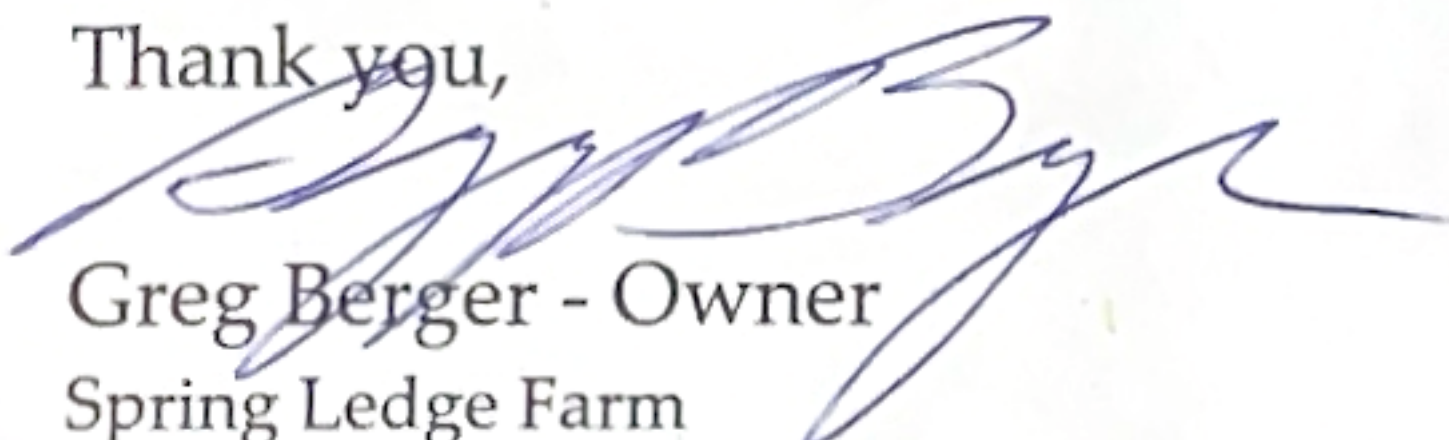
Independence is a NH value.
