

Line 17 - II-a.(a) Except in the case of an immediate or perceived threat to life or property,...

Line 20-21 - ... in the cities or towns where such dam ~~or beaver impoundment~~ is located, all abutters whose property abuts such dam, ~~interests will be directly affected by the removal, or lowering of the water level~~ at least 30 days prior to any action specified. The expense for such notification, shall be the responsibility to the landowner intending to remove such dam.

Line 24 - (b) 30 days prior to action, ~~t~~The landowner intending to remove a beaver dam or significantly lower the water level in cooperation with the local governing body of each of the cities or towns, shall request the legislative body hold a public informational meeting at least 15 days prior to any action. The municipality shall publish a notice of the public informational meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the action shall occur, or on the municipality's website, at least 7 days before the time set for the meeting. Expenses incurred from publication in the newspaper, shall be the responsibility of the landowner intending to remove such dam.
