Dear Chair Roy:

On behalf of the New Hampshire members of the National Rifle Association, I strongly urge you to oppose House Bill 1387.

HB 1387 would repeal RSA 507-D:6, a law that limits liability for dealers and manufacturers of firearms from frivolous lawsuits based on the presence or absence of specific features. Existing law does nothing to shield liability for manufacturers from claims based on an actual defect in the design or manufacturing of a product. In that respect, RSA 507-D:6 merely reinforces existing federal law covered under the Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act.

Frivolous lawsuits are a threat to the entire firearms industry which, in turn, threatens access to constitutionally protected products, degrading Second Amendment rights in New Hampshire, along with threatening the livelihoods of thousands of Granite Staters employed in a vibrant industry in New Hampshire.

For these reasons, the NRA opposes HB 1387.
