MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF WAR

SUBJECT: Request for Investigation into Alleged Geoengineering Operations in Vermont

DATE: 11 November 2025, 10:15 EDT

1. Purpose: This memorandum requests an immediate and thorough investigation into alleged geoengineering operations involving aerial spraying over Vermont, which may pose serious risks to public health and the environment.

2. Background:

- On 16 August 2025, a jet tanker was observed spraying unusual patterns in Vergennes, Vermont, at 18:30 EDT.

- On 8 July 2025, intense flight activity was reported, reflecting a 30-day period of operations prior to severe flooding in the Northeast Kingdom (NEK) area on 10 July 2025.

- These activities, potentially linked to military aircraft, have raised concerns about environmental contamination and weather manipulation.

3. Current Administration Efforts:

- The administration's reduction of funding to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) demonstrates a commitment to transparency and accountability.

- However, the Department of Defense (DoD) has maintained consistent funding for weather modification research, suggesting a need for oversight of these programs.

4. Concerns:

- Local reports and laboratory analyses indicate possible heavy metal contamination in water and snow.

- Air quality data shows episodic pollution spikes.

- Vermont Air National Guard personnel report ongoing operations with limited communication from leadership.

- Many people are concerned about these activities. What studies on citizens' health and well-being from environmental pollution have there been? Have there been any studies on the health effects? Is the DoD concerned about the alleged huge impact on the weather and the environment? Are you aware of this? Is there a business case for disrupting the weather and its potential impact on the health of Americans?

5. Requested Actions:

- Determine if the DoD is conducting these spraying operations and under what authority.

- Identify the source of reported environmental contamination and its health impacts.

- Assess the possible role of these flights in the 10 July 2025 flooding.

- Ensure transparency and accountability within the chain of command.

- Review any outdated directives guiding these activities.

6. Recommendation: Let us take professional measures to address this. I urge a public response and comprehensive investigation to protect public interest—are you prepared for the consequences of ignoring it and adverse effects on the people? An annotated bibliography with detailed evidence is attached as Enclosure 1. Please keep the President informed, as his administration prioritizes accountability.

SUBJECT: Supporting Evidence for Geoengineering Investigation Request
DATE: 11 November 2025

This enclosure provides detailed technical evidence and references supporting the memorandum requesting an investigation into alleged geoengineering operations in Vermont. Each entry includes a description and relevance to the case.

 - Description: Reports intense geoengineering flight activity on 8 July 2025, reflecting a 30-day period of operations, just before the 10 July 2025 flooding in Vermont's Northeast Kingdom (NEK) area. Includes a flight path map showing dense aircraft trajectories over the northeastern U.S.
 - Relevance: Suggests weather modification linked to flooding, supported by the attached image, potentially involving military aircraft.
2. X Post by Ed (@Ed45530618), 17 August 2025, 15:44 EDT

 - Description: Documents a jet tanker spraying toxic fly ash over Vergennes, Vermont, on 16 August 2025 at 18:30 EDT, with the spray persisting, expanding into a cloud, and turning on/off as the camera panned east.
 - Relevance: Indicates deliberate aerosol release, inconsistent with natural contrails, and aligns with FlightRadar24 data showing no commercial flights.
3. Inductively Coupled Plasma-Optical Emission Spectrometer (ICP-OES) Test, 16 February 2025
 - Description: Analysis of Vergennes tap water detected cadmium at 0.191 mg/L (38 times the EPA MCL of 0.005 mg/L), silver at 0.0324 mg/L, and elevated calcium, magnesium, potassium (1.58 mg/L), and sodium (13 mg/L). Aluminum was below detection limit.
 - Relevance: Suggests heavy metal contamination potentially from atmospheric deposition, supporting claims of aerial spraying.

4. Snow Sample Analysis, 16 February 2025, and 16 October 2024

- Description: Samples from Vergennes (porch roof, ground) and Bolton showed silver (0.0333–0.057 mg/L), aluminum (0.0201–0.0364 mg/L), calcium (0.989–1.34 mg/L), potassium (0.187–0.335 mg/L), and magnesium (0.149–0.197 mg/L), all exceeding typical snow levels (<0.001 mg/L for silver, <0.01 mg/L for aluminum, etc.).

- Relevance: Indicates possible atmospheric deposition of metals consistent with coal fly ash, linking to geoengineering claims.

5. PM2.5 Air Quality Data, 1–5 August 2025

- Description: Real-time monitoring showed peaks of 17 µg/m³ in Bennington (1 August), 10–12 µg/m³ in Rutland and Underhill (2–5 August), within EPA “Good” to “Moderate” range but suggesting episodic pollution.

- Relevance: Correlates with spraying incidents, indicating regional air quality fluctuations potentially from aerosol release.

6. ICAMS FY 2025 Federal Weather Enterprise Budget and Coordination Report

- Description: Details consistent DoD funding for weather modification research (e.g., cloud seeding, atmospheric intervention) over FY 2023–2025, contrasting with NOAA’s reduced budget due to current administration cuts.

- Relevance: Suggests DoD’s ongoing role in weather modification, possibly linked to observed flights, and highlights funding divergence.

7. National Weather Service Report, 10 July 2025

- Description: Reported over 100 roads closed and 212 rescues in the NEK area due to severe flooding, comparable to the 2011 Irene event.

- Relevance: Supports the timing of geoengineering flights reported on 8 July 2025 as a possible factor in antecedent soil moisture.

8. Vermont Daily Chronicle, 9 January 2024

- Description: Noted local observations of geoengineered weather patterns, potentially linked to flooding events.

- Relevance: Provides historical context for weather modification claims in Vermont.

9. FlightRadar24 Data, 16 August 2025, and 8 July 2025

- Description: Showed no commercial flights during the Vergennes spraying incident and the 30-day flight activity period, suggesting military or non-commercial aircraft.

- Relevance: Supports the hypothesis of DoD or affiliated agency involvement.

10. Vermont Air National Guard Reports, Anonymous Sources

- Description: Credible but anonymous personnel report ongoing geoengineering operations, with the commanding general refusing to discuss them, possibly following previous Biden administration directives.

- Relevance: Indicates internal awareness and lack of transparency within the military.

11. Washington Post, January 2023

- Description: Reported Congressman Frank Lucas’s push to make NOAA independent amid planned funding slashes for unreauthorized agencies.

- Relevance: Context for current administration’s NOAA budget cuts, contrasting with DoD funding stability.

12. Wikipedia: Second Presidency of Donald Trump

- Description: Notes severe funding and staff cuts to NOAA under the current administration.
- Relevance: Supports the narrative of reduced NOAA influence, highlighting the need for DoD oversight.

13. X Post Discussion, Various Dates

- Description: Includes photographic evidence, weather app screenshots, and public discourse amplifying concerns about geoengineering.
- Relevance: Provides additional community-sourced data supporting the incidents.
