Re: Testimony in Opposition to HB 1702-FN, relative to notice requirements and enforcement for pharmacies dispensing medication intended to induce chemical abortions.

Position: INEXPEDIENT TO LEGISLATE

The Lovering Health Center in Greenland is a non-profit licensed health care facility in New Hampshire. We have provided safe, evidence-based abortion care for over 45 years. Our practice and our patients would be directly impacted by HB 1702-FN. We oppose this bill as it contradicts best medical practice and mandates the presentation of unsubstantiated, medically unproven guidance that could harm patients.

HB 1702-FN is an anti-abortion attempt to influence patient behavior by mandating misleading and unproven “medication abortion reversal” information. The research supporting the safety and efficacy of medication abortion, and mifepristone specifically, is vast. However, there is NO consistent body of research adequately proving that “medication abortion reversal” is a safe or effective option for patients. Patients trust us to present them with full, evidence-based options as part of abortion care. Posting information in our clinic about “medication abortion reversal” implies that it deserves to be considered alongside evidence-based and proven healthcare strategies. It does not.

Additionally, specifically directing patients to a non-licensed, anti-abortion group is NOT effective healthcare. It is an anti-abortion mandate that has no place in a licensed healthcare facility or licensed pharmacy in New Hampshire.

I urge you to vote **Inexpedient to Legislate** on HB 1702-FN.
