House Speaker applauds passage of Parental Bill of Rights

Concord, NH: Speaker Sherman Packard (R-Londonderry) released the following statement after the passage of HB-10, relative to establishing the parental bill of rights, on a 212-161 vote:

The passage of HB 10 is a victory for parents who have been demanding transparency in education and respect for their natural rights in the care and upbringing of their own children.
