Key Housing Bill Passes the House

Concord, NH: Speaker Sherman Packard (R-Londonderry) released the following statement after the passage of SB4, relative to commercial property assessed clean energy and resiliency (C-Pacer):

Speaker Packard: “SB4 is a crucial bill for New Hampshire’s housing market, and I’d like to thank Senator Dan Innis for his efforts in putting this legislation through.
