Members of the House Housing Committee Visit Local Building Company

Lyndeborough, NH – the House Housing Committee recently toured Tiny Houses of NH in Lyndeborough, exploring innovative solutions to the state's housing affordability crisis. The visit highlighted the potential of tiny homes as sustainable, cost-effective housing options for individuals and couples:

Chairman Joe Alexander (R-Goffstown) emphasized the significance of such initiatives:

“To amplify the legislature’s commitment to addressing the housing challenges our state is facing, HB 577 passed out of the Senate Commerce Committee by a vote of 5-1 today which would allow the use of tiny homes as accessory dwelling units statewide.”

He continued, “Tiny homes represent a practical and scalable approach to our housing challenges. They offer affordability, sustainability, and the opportunity to utilize New Hampshire's skilled workforce, making them a vital component in addressing our housing needs.”

Tiny Houses of NH exemplifies this model by constructing energy-efficient, affordable homes using locally sourced materials and employing New Hampshire-based craftsmen. These homes are designed to be both environmentally friendly and financially accessible.

The company's commitment to local employment and sustainable building practices underscores the potential of tiny homes to support both the housing market and the state's economy. As the House Housing Committee continues to seek creative solutions to the

state's housing challenges, initiatives like Tiny Houses of NH offer a promising path forward.

Background: Chairman Joe Alexander is the prime sponsor of HB 577, relative to modifying the definition of ADUs, which passed out of the NH House as OTP/A on a voice vote on 03/06/25. The House Housing Committee began as a special committee formed by Speaker Sherman Packard in the 2023-2024 term to help find solutions to the housing crisis.
