**N.H. Legislative Golf Classic Slated for Monday, June 23 at Loudon Country Club**

Concord, NH: The 2023 version of the New Hampshire Legislative Golf Classic returns to the Granite State on Monday, June 23, when Loudon Country Club hosts this charity event, beginning at 8:30 a.m. The Golf Classic brings together lawmakers from both parties and both legislative chambers for bipartisan fun while raising funds for Manchester's Liberty House which supports homeless and transitioning veterans. The solons are joined on the course by friends, influencers, and golfers of all sorts:

"This is a fantastic event," noted Rep. Mike Moffett (R-Loudon) who is one of the organizers. "It's inspiring to see folks from both sides of the aisle coming together in common cause while also having fun." The last Classic, in 2023, netted over \$20,000 for the Liberty House cause.

"This is a great way to close out six months of legislative business," added Rep. Jim Maggiore (D-North Hampton) another organizer. "The rewards of serving in our citizen legislature are intrinsic, not financial, and this event epitomizes what is so special about New Hampshire."

The Golf Classic features a scramble format with four-person teams competing for all kinds of prizes. Numerous raffle items will be awarded at the afternoon social, which will also feature New Hampshire Governor Kelly Ayotte. Anyone interested in registering a team or
