Speaker Packard applauds the passage of HB 10

Concord, NH: Speaker Sherman Packard (R-Londonderry) released the following statement after the House concurred with the Senate (210-160) on HB 10, establishing the parental bill of rights:

“Today, with the passage of HB 10, the legislature has taken a decisive step to uphold parental rights. This legislation reaffirms a fundamental principle: that parents have the right to be informed and involved in decisions affecting their children’s lives.

House Republicans campaigned on a commitment to put families first and to restore the rightful role of parents in decisions impacting their children’s education, health, and well-being. This bill fulfills that promise and defends the values that matter most to countless Granite Staters.

We will continue to protect families and push back against any attempt to erode the rights of parents who know and love their children best.”
