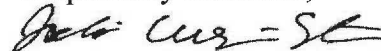
Please find enclosed a Report for the YDC Claims Administration and Settlement Fund based on data and information as of March 31, 2026.

Report for the YDC Claims Administration and Settlement Fund

March 2026

The New Hampshire Legislature established the YDC Claims Administration and Settlement Fund (“the Fund”) under NH RSA 21-M:11-a, for victims of sexual and other abuse at New Hampshire’s youth detention center facilities in prior decades to provide an administrative process as a trauma-informed, victim-centered alternative to litigation for the efficient and fair resolution of claims against the State of New Hampshire.

This Report provides data and information from the YDC Claims Administration, in consultation with the Attorney General’s Office, about claims activity and costs to the Fund.

Information about Claims includes: the number and total claim amount requested for filed claims; the nature of filed claims; the number and nature of pending claims; the number of claims resolved with awards under the Fund; the total actual settlement amounts approved for payment under the Fund; and the number of claims denied, dismissed or withdrawn. Information about claims is based on the YDC Claims Administration docket at the close of the reporting period.

Information about Costs includes: payments for resolved claims (including fees and costs of attorneys who represent claimants); costs for claims processing by the YDC Claims Administration; and costs of the Attorney General’s Office outside of the ordinary operational expenses of the Department of Justice. Information about the YDC Claims Administration costs for claims processing is provided by the YDC Claims Administration. Other figures for information about costs are provided by the Department of Justice.

Once a claim is determined to be administratively complete, it is assigned a completion date and forwarded to the AG Designee for review.

As of March 31, 2026, the average award amount (including interest) for the 425 claims resolved with an award is \$563,054.73. When taking into account all closed claims, including those that did not receive an award, the average award amount (including interest) is \$412,583.21. For the 425 claims resolved with settlement, claimants sought \$469,132,825.00¹ before settling for a total of \$239,298,259.46.

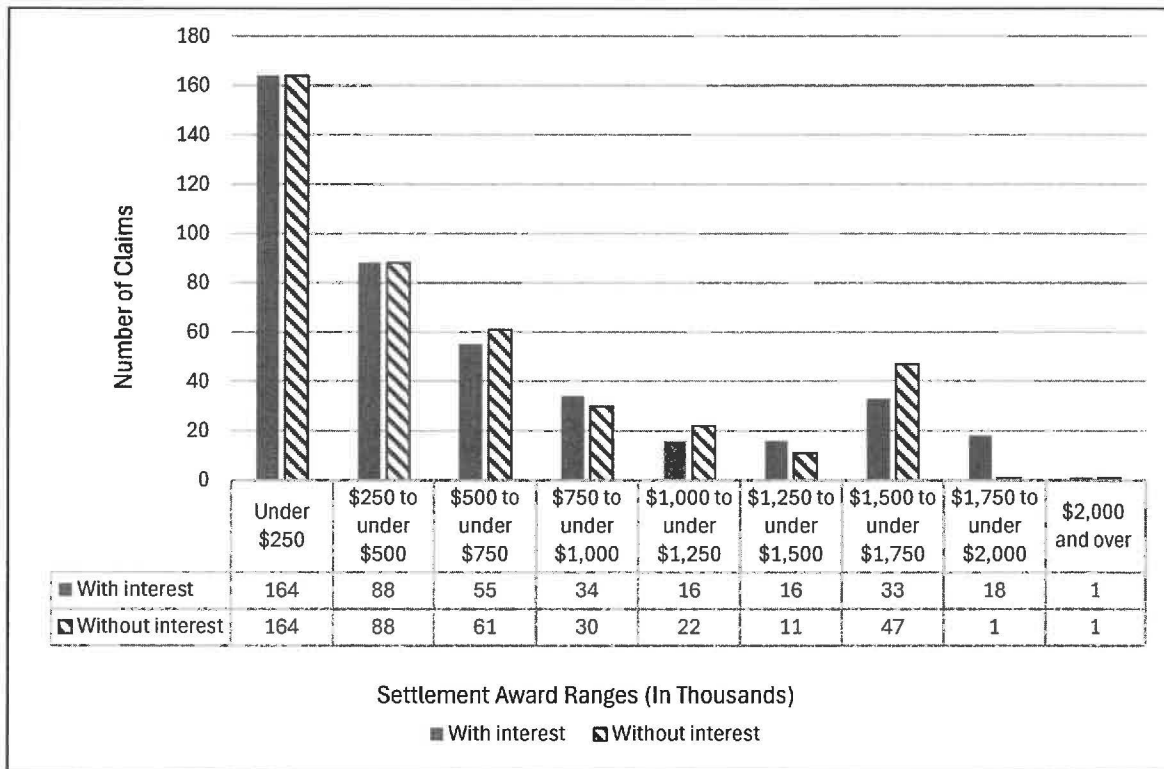
