Rep. Lynn moved that the Committee approve the Consent Agenda, that is, approve Final Proposals 2024-189, 2024-230, 2025-5, 2025-6, 2025-7, 2025-9, 2025-11, 2025-17, 2025-61, 2025-62, 2025-81, 2025-20, 2025-44, 2025-45, 2025-67, 2025-72, 2025-82, 2025-21, 2025-59, 2025-43, 2025-52, 2025-54, 2025-68, 2025-69, and 2025-83; and conditionally approve Final Proposals 2024-195, 2024-243, 2024-246, 2025-8, 2025-10, 2025-13, 2025-40, 2025-49, 2025-50, 2025-53, and 2025-65, based on the agencies' Conditional Approval Requests or amended Conditional Approval Requests.

Sen. Lang designated Sen. McGough as an alternate for Sen. Reardon, who was absent.

4. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2025-60 from the Department of Health and Human Services (Home Visit for Postpartum and Newborn Assessment). Sen. Lang suggested the rule be postponed until the July 17, 2025 Committee meeting.

No action was taken.

5. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2025-47 from the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (Amendments to Licensure and Discipline of Regulated Professions). Executive Director Deanna Jurius testified on behalf of the Office. Rep. McGuire expressed concerns that one of the Boards under the OPLC represented that they were unable to participate in the development of Office forms. Director Jurius testified that many of the concerns expressed to her would be alleviated once the Office implemented the new online licensing system, currently in development.

Sen. Lang moved to approve Final Proposal 2025-47.

Sen. Innis seconded.

Adopted.

6. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2025-51 from the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources (Volunteer Programs). Andrea Olsson testified on behalf of the Department.

Sen. Innis moved to conditionally approve Final Proposal 2025-51 based on the submitted conditional approval request.

Rep. Lynn seconded.

7. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2025-70 from the Fish and Game Department (General Administration, and OHRV and Snowmobile Registration Requirements). Jessica Whelehan testified on behalf of the Department. Sen. Lang expressed concerns that the processing time for applications under the current rule did not align with other Department rules for processing applications for the same privilege. Ms. Whelehan testified that the Department would change the proposal to bring the rules into alignment and requested an oral conditional approval.

Sen. McGough moved to conditionally approve Final Proposal 2025-70 based on the Department's conditional approval request and the oral amended conditional approval request.

Representative McGuire moved to approve the Notice.
