The proposed readoption with amendment of rules: Saf-C 508.01; various rules in Saf-C 1000; and various rules in Saf-C 1900 reflect the fee increases, resulting from 2025 N.H. Laws Ch 141:231-241, to certain Division of Motor Vehicle fees.
