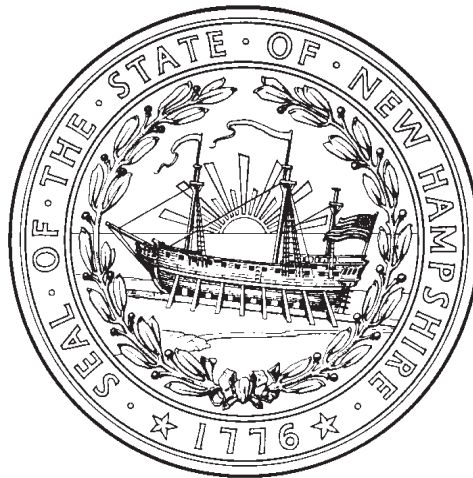

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VETO MESSAGES

August 1, 2025

Governor's Veto Message Regarding Senate Bill 213

By the authority vested in me, pursuant to part II, Article 44 of the New Hampshire Constitution, on August 1, 2025, I have vetoed Senate Bill 213, relative to electioneering by public employees and relative to absentee voting.

I am vetoing this legislation as it conflicts with other bills I have recently signed into law regarding absentee ballots. Additionally, I intend to work with the bill sponsors on the issue of electioneering to ensure that public employees can engage in public discourse without misusing their official positions for political purposes.

For the reasons stated above, I have vetoed Senate Bill 213.

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PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO SENATE RULES

Amend Senate Rule 2-3 as follows:

2-3 Use of Electronic Devices - The use of electronic devices by Senators, with the exception of approved Senate-issued devices is prohibited on the Senate floor during session, unless the Senate is in recess or unless otherwise approved by the Senate.

Amend Senate Subsidiary Motions as follows:

Subsidiary Motions

Motion	Debatable	Amendable	Notes
Refer (or Recommit)	Yes	Yes	Debatable only as to the propriety of a referral. Amendments limited to the committee to which the matter will be referred and any instructions thereto.

Amend Senate Rule 3-3 as follows:

3-3 Confidential Filing Requests - If requested by the sponsor, a proposed bill, resolution or petition shall not be made public, except by the sponsor, until published to be introduced into the Senate.

Amend Senate Rule 3-5 as follows:

3-5 Drafting Requests After Deadline - Notwithstanding the drafting deadline established in Rule 7-1, a Senate bill, Senate joint resolution, or Senate concurrent resolution may be accepted by the Office of Legislative Services for drafting and introduced into the Senate at any time prior to the crossover deadline established by Senate rules if the drafting request is approved by a majority of the Rules and Enrolled Bills Committee. Requests made under this paragraph shall contain detailed information on the scope and purpose of the intended legislation and shall not be confidential.

Amend Senate Rule 3-23 as follows:

3-23 Bills or Resolutions Laid on the Table - All bills or resolutions remaining on the table as of October 31 of the first year and at the end of session shall be made Inexpedient to Legislate at that time.

Amend Senate Rule 6-22 as follows:

6-22 Prohibitions - Constitutional amendment concurrent resolutions shall not appear on the Consent Calendar.

Amend Senate Rule 7-1 with inserting (s)-(y):

7-1 Deadlines
