




Second congressional district (NH-02)

- The second congressional district would comprise the rest of the state.
 - **Whole counties:** Coos, Cheshire, Grafton, and Sullivan.
 - **Partial counties:** Belknap, Carroll, Hillsborough, and Merrimack (all towns not included in NH-01).
- The Lakes Region moves to NH-02, while NH-01 keeps the Manchester area and the Seacoast.
- Overall, this map makes the congressional districts more compact, with NH-01 anchored firmly in the southeastern corner of the state.
