
Map on DRA 2020

- Visually compact - best practice for redistricting
- Simple and sensible
- Deviation of 43 vs. 177 in majority amendment
- Keeps county boundaries intact with only minor exceptions, vs. 6 of 10 in majority amendment
- Only violates 5 SAU boundaries (94% intact) vs. 10 SAUs in majority amendment
- Only moves 12 towns & wards vs. 75 in majority amendment
- Very competitive
- No packing of districts
- Follows 140 years of precedent
