Senator Carson is the President of the New Hampshire Senate and has represented her District in Londonderry since 2008. She previously served in the House for four terms. She has worked hard for bail reform, opposed right-to-work legislation, and backed a bill that would divide some private spaces by assigned sex at birth. She is a 17-year veteran of the U.S. Army and Army Reserve and advocates for veterans issues. She is an adjunct professor at Nashua Community College.
